The old city of Jiangzhou was the home to Emperor Li Shimin (Tang Dynasty A.D. 618-907), and his celebrated percussion orchestra. In fact, some of the earliest archaeological evidence of Chinese percussion music found has been unearthed in the Shanxi region.

Performances by **JIGU! THUNDER DRUMS OF CHINA** are deeply rooted in this rich heritage. An intricate blend of traditional and modern elements, this fascinating, innovative show, conceived by the producers of THE PEKING ACROBATS®, is sure to captivate audiences of all ages. The drummers, percussionists, and musicians of **JIGU! THUNDER DRUMS OF CHINA**, range in age from about 16 to 30 years old, and their youthful exuberance shines in every performance they give on their tours. Founded in 1988, the *Shanxi Jiangzhou Drum Art Ensemble* is known as **JIGU! THUNDER DRUMS OF CHINA** when they perform in the West. They have performed in many countries around the world including the United States, Canada, Denmark, Morocco, Singapore, Malaysia, Korea, Hong Kong, and Taiwan. This tour brought the group to such US cities as Los Angeles, CA; San Diego, CA; Dallas, TX; Houston, TX, and several cities in Florida. In 2009, they toured yet again, this time in the Fall of that year. On this tour, they visited Albuquerque, NM, Louisville, KY, Johnstown, PA, Daytona Beach, FL, the Chicago-land area in Illinois, several cities in the Carolinas and, once again, they returned to play several performances in Florida. Now, as **JIGU!
